

“200 CLUB”

Rules

- 1 To be a member of the 200 Club every member pays 50p as a one-off membership fee. This membership fee will not be included in the prize fund.
- 2 To be entered into the draw, each member pays £12 per year and is allocated one available number between 1 and 200.
- 3 If a member wishes, additional numbers may be bought at a cost of a further £12 per number.
- 4 To retain the allocated number(s), members must continue to pay £12 (or multiples thereof) at the time annual renewal is due.
- 5 Failure to pay £12 (or multiples thereof) will result in the member’s number(s) being withdrawn from the draw.
- 6 Money gathered during the Village Hall financial year (Oct – Sep) will be used to form the 200 Club prize fund for the next financial year and provide money to support the Village Hall.
- 7 Members joining after the end of September will be entered into the draw however their contribution will be added to the next years prize fund.
- 8 The money collected from 200 Club members will be split in two ways. 40% will be allocated to a prize fund and 60% will be allocated to support the maintenance and running of the Village Hall (which may also include reasonable expenses for the running of the 200 Club).
- 9 Six draws will be held during the year including the “Super Draw”. Draws will be on alternate months or if this is not possible, at a time deemed appropriate by the Village Hall Committee.
- 10 Numbers will be drawn where possible at meetings or events of various Essendon Village organisations.

- 11 The winning numbers (and names of winners) will be published on the Village Hall notice board and may also be posted on the Village Hall Facebook page, however only winning numbers will be published on Facebook.

- 12 The first draw of the year will be the Super Draw and will take place at the Village Hall AGM (or as soon as possible at the discretion of the Village Hall Committee). At this draw the prize fund will be disclosed and ONE number will receive a single prize consisting of the remainder of the of prize fund for the year after £400 has been deducted to cover the remaining five draws for the year.

- 13 THREE NUMBERS will be drawn at the remaining five draws of each year:
 - First number drawn will receive the 1st prize (£50)*
 - Second number drawn will receive 2nd prize (£20)*
 - Third number drawn will receive 3rd prize (£10)*

*In the event that there are insufficient prize funds to pay out these prizes, alternative amounts will be calculated based on 40% of the available funds as detailed in point 8.

Example: Based on 200 members each paying £12:

Total subscriptions for the year = £2400

Prize fund of 40% = £960 (60% (£1440) is allocated for Village Hall maintenance)

Draw 1 a single number will take the remainder of the £960 prize fund after £400 has been deducted to pay for draws 2-6 = £560

Draw 2-6 share £400 of the £960 prize fund = 1st £50, 2nd £20 & 3rd £10
